To discuss the response to be made in respect of the following application:

20/33264/FUL Aston Hall. Aston by Doxey – hangar and helipad.

The Council had received a letter from John and Ann Foster, the proprietors of Aston Hill Livery Stables listing their objections to the planning application which had been forwarded to Councillors and which was read out by the Chair along with the comments submitted by Cllr Turnbull.
